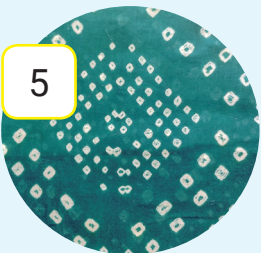
These are made with bendable materials like grass, stems and straw which are woven together to form mats and vessels.
